



MyHat

Materials:

- Worsted Weight yarn 2 colors
- Crochet hook 4.25 mm [G hook] [Can use larger or smaller hooks depending on size of hat]
- Button
- Yarn threader to thread button

Size:

- Adult large 21" circumference

Stitches used:

- Ch = chain
- Sc = single crochet
- Sl st = slip stitch
- Seed stitch = one sc and then one dc alternating across row.

Instructions:

Note: Do not turn at end of rows. All done with front facing. Ch 1 after join and 1 stitch is in joining stitch.

Magic loop, crochet 8 sc in loop. Join.

CROWN

Using Color 1: [gray]

- Row 1: 2 sc in each sc [16 sc]
- Row 2: sc evenly across row [16 sc]
- Row 3: *2sc in stitch [increase], sc in next 1 sc* across
- Row 4: *2 sc in stitch [increase], sc in next 2 sc* across
- Row 5: *2 sc in stitch [increase], sc in next 3 sc* across

Using Color 2: [black]

- Row 6: *2 sc in stitch [increase], sc in next 4 sc* across

- Row 7: *2 sc in stitch [increase], sc in next 5 sc* across

Using Color 1: [gray]

- Row 8: *2 sc in stitch [increase], sc in next 6 sc* across
- Row 9: sc across [even with no increase] across
- Row 10: *2 sc in stitch [increase], sc in next 7 sc* across

Using Color 2: [black]

- Row 11: Seed Stitch [sc in next st, dc in next stitch] repeat around row. [even with no increase]
- Row 12: Seed Stitch [sc in next st, dc in next stitch] repeat around row. [even with no increase]

Repeat rows 11 and 12 changing colors as needed doing 3 rows of gray and 2 rows of black. Thus you do 3 more groups of gray and 3 groups of black. Adjust for the length of hat you wish to have. I wanted the hat to cover my ears well.

Finishing: **Using Color 2 [black]** do reverse sc around brim.

- Fold front of hat up and place button securely in center of front as hat shows.
- I had to sew securely the flip up so that it is as shown. [Again, I wanted my ears covered by the hat.]
