It looks better in reality than the images above. Pattern repeats throughout scarf.

Materials:

- Soft Worsted type #4 yarn:
- Blue [hat/scarf 5 oz] [hat 1 oz and scarf 3 ½ oz]
- Heather Blue [hat/scarf 7 oz] [hat 3 ½ oz and scarf 3 ½ oz]
- Black [hat/scarf 3 oz] [hat 1 oz and scarf 2 oz]
- White [hat/scarf 3 oz] [hat 1 oz and scarf 2 oz]
- Hooks:
- J Hook
- H Hook
- F Hook 4.25 size

Size of Scarf: 7 ¾" by 60 3/4" including trim [trim is about ¾" wide]

Instruction:

Using J Hook Chain 24 with Blue Heather. [24 ch and initial magic loop]

Note: There will be 12 groups of pattern sequence for 60" length scarf

Row 1: Using H Hook sc in 2nd ch from hook and across to end. [23 sc]

Row 2: Ch1, sc across, change color to black in last stitch. Fasten Off Blue Heather.

PATTERN:

Row 3-4: Ch1, sc across to end. Change to white color in last stitch. Fasten Off Black.

Row 5-6: Ch1, sc across to end. Change to blue in last stitch. Fasten Off White.

Row 7: Using J hook..... Ch1, hdc across to end.

Row 8- 11: Ch3, [fpdc, bpdc across to end.]. Note: fpdc in fpdc and bpdc in bpdc. Change to white in last stitch. Fasten Off Blue.

Row 12-13: Using H hook...... Ch1, sc across. Change to black in last stitch. Fasten Off White.

Row 14-15: Ch1, sc across. Change to Blue Heather in last stitch. Fasten Off Black.

Row 16-17: Ch1, sc across.

Row 18-19: Ch1, sc across. Change to black in last stitch. Fasten Off Blue Heather.

REPEAT ROWS 3-19 TEN TIMES [You now should have 11 sequences of pattern done.]
REPEAT ROWS 3-17. [There are a total of 12 sequences.]

EDGING: Right Side Facing

Row 1: Using Blue Heather and using H hook Ch1, sc around with 3 sc in corners.

Row 2: Still using Blue Heather and H hook Ch1, Reverse sc around with extra reverse sc in center corner sc. Fasten Off. Hide any ends. Block.
