

## STAR STITCH SCARF: [ch 26+3=29] [man's scarf appx length= 60" and 7" wide plus trim]



## HOW TO DO STAR STITCH:

Chain a multiple of 2, plus 3

**Row 1:** insert hook in second ch from hook, pull a loop through; insert hook in next ch from hook, pull a loop through; do this until there are 6 loops on your hook, yoh and pull through all 6 loops (this makes the “spokes” of the star); ch1 to finish stitch and make the “eye” of the star

**Following stitches in row 1:** insert hook in “eye” you just made, pull a loop through; insert hook in last “spoke” of previous star, pull a loop through, insert hook in same foundation ch that the last “spoke” of previous star is in, pull loop through; pull loops through next 2 ch (you should have 6 loops on your hook now); yoh and pull through all 6 loops; ch 1 to finish stitch and make the “eye” of the star. Continue to end, and hdc in last ch.

**Row 2:** ch2, counts as a hdc; make 2 hdc in each “eye” of previous row across, then hdc in last st (you’ll have an even number of hdc’s on this row, counting the beginning ch2)

**Row 3:** ch3, insert hook in second ch from hook and draw up a loop, draw a loop up from next ch, draw a loop up from first, second, and third stitches (so you have 6 loops total on your hook); yoh and draw through all 6 loops, ch1 to finish stitch and make the “eye” of the star. Continue making star stitches as you did in row 1.

Repeat rows 2 and 3 until you’re finished, then tie off regularly and weave in ends. I really hope this made sense to everybody.

# SCARF INSTRUCTIONS:



change color at beginning of row 2.

Note: Pattern above can be repeated throughout [12 times in total for 60" scarf appx] or just put this pattern on both ends of scarf and make body of scarf solid color using star stitch throughout.

## Pattern Sequence:

Chain 29

- Do row 1-3 above in heather blue.
- Do Row 2-3 in black.
- Do Row 2-3 in white.
- Do Row 2-3 in blue, Do 2-3 in blue, Do 2-3 in blue [should have 3 rows of stars].
- Do Row 2-3 in white.
- Do Row 2-3 in black.

Do Row 2-3 in Blue Heather. Continue doing Row 2-3 in Blue Heather until 52" long.

- Do black row 2-3.
- Do white row 2-3.
- Do blue row to have 3 rows of stars.
- Do white row 2-3.
- Do black row 2-3.
- Do blue heather row 2-3.

## Edging Sequence:

- Row 1: attach blue heather somewhere with sl stitch. Ch1, sc around with 3 sc in corners. Join.
- Row 2: ch1, reverse sc around with 2 reverse sc in center of corners. Join. End off. Hide ends.
